

National Drug Take Back Day is April 26, 2025

We keep talking about it because it is SO important. Keep your loved ones safe by disposing of unused or expired medications.

Drug Take Back Sites accept:

- Capsules
- Creams
- Inhalers
- Non-aerosol sprays
- Ointments
- Patches
- Pills
- Vials



Pet meds are also accepted.

Drug Take Back Day results from October 2024:

- Total Law Enforcement Participation: 4,425
- Total Collection Sites: 4,644
- Total Weight Collected: 629,953 lbs. (314 tons)

Total Weight All Time: 19,200,440 lbs. (9,600 tons)

Do Your Part—Take Them Back

The FTC reports that \$12.5 Billion was lost to scams and fraud in 2024 and older adults were hit hard.

Don't Get Scammed......

Verify phone calls

If you receive a call and aren't sure if the company is legitimate or who you're speaking with, hang up. Search for a verified number on the company website. If someone calls claiming to be from your bank and you feel uncomfortable, hang up and call the number on the back of your card before providing any personal or financial information.

Beware of urgency

Scammers notoriously apply pressure by saying your account is compromised, claiming they'll cut off your services or threatening legal action. Take a pause and tell a trusted friend or family member about the situation before making any financial decisions.

Be cautious of upfront fees and guaranteed returns

If an opportunity seems too good to be true, it probably is. Look up reviews of the company to check its reputation and trustworthiness.

Don't be pressured to pay with gift cards

Utility companies, banks, the IRS or any other government agency will **never** request payment in the form of a gift card. Don't share the number on the back of the gift card with anyone you don't know.





Saving money in 2025!! Great deals to look for

March

March is National Frozen Food Month!! Expect to see discounts and coupons for frozen food brands. It's a great time to stock up your freezer! Luggage—Look for mark downs between the holiday and summer vacation Perfume and Candy—prices drop as low as 50% after Valentine's Day

April

Athletic shoes get marked down 40-60% by some retailers and you can find clearance deals as much as 70-80% off.

Grill accessories—deals are on in April but for better deals on grills, you need to wait for Fall.

Mattresses—new models come out in June, so look for deep discounts in April and May.



Inside The Home



Test your home's smoke and 🚨 carbon monoxide alarms.



Don't use electrical appliances with frayed cords.



Check for water around 🚢 electrical appliances.



Clean debris from your clothes 💶 dryer lint trap and exhaust duct.

Outside The Home



Remove dead leaves and other debris around foundations. decks, porches, and stairs.



Check grills for rust, worn parts, insects, grease, and other debris before use.



Grills should only be used when at least 10 feet away from your house or any building.
